

GENEALOGY – INTRODUCTION TO LEGACY 7.5

Objectives

This course introduces a genealogical computer program to record family history. It intended to provide instruction on methods of carrying out research although some advice may be given on possible locations of source material and problems discussed.

Description

You will explore the program and its basic facilities, such as customising the screens, recording data, note preparation, backing up, importing and exporting files and printing data. At the centre you will enter your own family data into the program using the methods as given in the manual and save the material to a flash drive.

Prerequisites

Basic skills are required for this course.

An understanding of, and the ability to use, external storage, such as a CD or a flash drive is necessary as well an understanding of files and folders.

Familiarity with the Save and Save As procedures is required.

You will need to bring your own flash drive to use in the class and at home.
